COMMUNITY TRANSPORT

Did you know that there has been a Community Transport Scheme operational in Pulborough and the surrounding area since the 1970's?

The transport scheme helps local people who have difficulty in using public transport, to get to essential medical appointments. So far this year we have completed over 550 journeys.



We also have a Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle which enables wheelchair users to access their appointments. This vehicle is affectionately known as 'The Blue Angel' and completes about 50 trips per year. As well as being used by locals living in their own homes it is also used by the local nursing homes.
